A quick overview of Corion C 5000 iu:

Corion 5000IU is a most admired therapy used in the treatment of infertility in both men and women. This assists a woman to beat her fertility by solving her issues related with ovulation and helps a man to beat his fertility trouble by increasing his sperm count. It has a notable application in the management of Cryptorchidism in adolescent boys that aid the testes to reside down into the scrotum. Corion 5000IU contains a generic drug known as Human Chorionic Gonadotropin (HCG) as the active ingredient.

Working action of Corion C 5000 iu:

Human Chorionic Gonadotropin (HCG) facilitates the release of an egg from the ovary (ovulation) in women. It also promotes the growth of the corpus luteum at the commencement of gestation, which causes the creation of Progesterone hormone. Progesterone is responsible for the maintenance of a pregnancy. HCG helps in the creation of androgens in men and androgen formed leads to the growth of secondary sex characteristics, which shore up the testicular descent. Moreover, it also helps the formation of testosterone in the Leydig cells resulting in the augment of sperm count.

What is the dosing regimen of Corion C 5000 iu?

Commercially this is available in the injection from and the commonly used dose is 5000IU. An infertile woman has to inject 5000IU to 10,000IU of Corion through intramuscular route or subcutaneous route one day followed by last day of Menotropins. An infertile man has to inject 4000IU of Corion through intramuscular route or subcutaneous route thrice a week for 6 to 9 months followed by 2000IU thrice a week for an extra 3 months. An adolescent boy (4 to 9 years) is recommended to inject 5000IU of Corion through intramuscular route on every other day for four injections.

What are the unwanted effects of Corion C 5000 iu?

The common undesired effects may likely to occur such as bad temper, frustration, nausea, irritation, lethargy, drowsiness, headache, chest pain, and yellowing, or redness at the injection site.

What are the precautions and warnings while using Corion C 5000 iu?

- A woman must follow a gynecological exam before initiating treatment with Corion injection.
- The use of Corion injection may develop the risk of multiple pregnancies, so it better to consult a doctor prior to the use of this medicine.
- You should not recommend this medicine to children under 4 years of age for the management of Cryptorchidism.
- If you are already pregnant women and breastfeeding mother should not use Corion injection.

WHAT HAPPEN IN CASE OF MISSED DOSE OF CORION C 5000 iu?

Avoid the utilization of excess quantity of injection to entrap the skipped dose.

Always confer with doctor if you omit any dose of this injection.

WHAT HAPPEN IN CASE OF OVERDOSE OF CORION C 5000 iu?

Get some emergency medical treatment from your nearby healthcare center, if you face any overdosing of Corion.
